In view of the ensuing Local Bodies elections in Jammu & Kashmir since September, 2018 and keen involvement of people in these elections, the Election Commission of India has decided to extend the last date for lodging of claims and objections in the State of Jammu and Kashmir in connection with the Special Summary Revision of Electoral Rolls with reference to 01-01-2019 as the qualifying date, including and up to 23rd December, 2018.

It is therefore informed to the general public as well as all the political parties that all the logistics in place for the said summary revision shall continue to be functional till 23rd of December and also Special Camps shall be organised on 16th December and if need arises another one on 23rd shall be organised to further facilitate the updation and purification of the Electoral Roll with reference to 01-01-2019 as the qualifying date.
