ALMOST ALL POLLING PARTIES REACH POLLING STATIONS FOR SRINAGAR PC

The dispatch of the Polling Parties across the five districts of the Srinagar parliamentary constituency was finalized in the evening hours today on 12th May. The de-centralised system of dispatch was planned keeping in view the logistics. The Dispatch of Polling Parties took place from 18 centres across the 5 districts of Srinagar, Shopian, Pulwama, Budgam, and Ganderbal on 12 May. The Fourth Phase of Lok Sabha elections in the Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir will be held on 13th May. Polling will be held across 2,135 Polling Stations in 1,323 Locations. The dispatch of Polling parties with EVM'S started at 8 A.M and was personally overseen by the Chief Electoral Officer J&K; Sh. Pandurang .K. Pole (IAS). Around 2700 Vehicles have been deployed by the administration for the successful and smooth conduct of elections.

Speaking on the welfare provisions in place for the polling parties the CEO said, "The District administrations have been directed to plan for the welfare of the parties well in advance to ensure a smooth and efficient election process. Additionally, special Nodal officers have been appointed across the districts to take care of the welfare of the polling parties."



Polling in PC- SRINAGAR shall commence from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. and shall continue till the last



voter has cast his vote. A total of 17,47,810 voters are expected to cast their votes. It is pertinent to mention here that 100% Polling stations in Srinagar parliamentary constituency will have CCTV type cameras for LIVE webcasting. The Polling shall be viewed LIVE from District headquarters as well as from the Central Command Centres established at Jammu and Srinagar.
